Theme:

“Theologizing in Context: What Shapes Latino/a Theology”

Theme Description:

The 2010 Colloquium will focus on the various contexts in which Latino/a theology is researched, practiced, and taught. We will begin by naming the academic context of Latino/a theology, situating it in light of the study of American Catholicism and theology in the Americas. Our second session moves us to the lived context of Latino/a theology, allowing us to leave the walls of the meeting rooms and experience the particularity and richness of Cuban-American Catholicism through visits to the two most iconic locales that represent the complexity and flavor of the Cuban-American community in Miami. On our second day we will begin by examining the various pedagogical contexts in which Latino/a theology is taught and received: undergraduate, graduate in preparation for ministry, and academic graduate settings. In the second session of the day we will focus on the broader context in which Latino/a theology exists, focusing on two pressing issues within our communities: the growth of Pentecostalism and violence against women. Our final day will focus on the future context of Latino/a theology, drawing from the future of our theology, our Latino/a doctoral students.

The underlying impulse of this colloquium is, in many ways, a “state of the union” of ACHTUS and our academic discourse. It is my hope that we can situate our work in light of the various publics our theology engages, yet also be reminded by the younger scholars in our midst of those things on our immediate horizon.
